

WMRRA BYLAWS: SCHEDULE A

Paid Position Compensation

As outlined in the bylaws, the Board of Directors, BoD, publishes acceptable pay rates for individuals performing duties for the club.

Race Round Positions

These positions exist to manage duties on a race weekend. They are paid by the round. If duties need to be split within a round, the total paid to all individuals shall not exceed the budgeted amount.

Course Marshall	Responsible for overseeing the course, track setup and teardown staff	\$250
Track Steward	Monitors Pits, assists Start/Finish during wave starts, responds to track incidents, assists Course Marshall during course of round.	\$150

Corner Capt.	Paid Position Manage & Train Corner Staff; Rider Safety on Track; Corner Workers	\$200
Crash	Provides crash recovery services on course. Provides own vehicle for this role	\$200

Pit Gate Lead	Control of track entrance; Gate signaling; Reports to Race Control	\$170
Pit Gate Asst		\$125
Pit Steward	Volunteer; Pit safety and conditions	\$125
Scoring	(Falls under 3rd VP) Official score, and timing keeper; provided race results; track-side Wi-Fi, and intra-net systems; Shall coordinate scoring efforts with Riders Rep and Referee	\$200
Registrar	(falls under 3rd VP) Manages licenses; manages race registrations; trophies & awards presentations.	\$250
Registrar Assistant	Assists registrar	\$150
Race Day Treasurer	Treasurer shall collect dues from members and all funds owed to WMRRA; Manage the clubs funds within state and federal laws; Tracks financial health of club; Provides monthly financials.	\$150
Radio Maintainer	Maintains the Radio Systems. Responsible for maintenance, charging, transport to and from track.	\$140

Airfence Lead	Maintains airfence, additionally does duties of Track Setup and Teardown Crew.	\$250
Track Set-Up and Tear Down Crew	This position pays \$200 per person, up to 3 people. If more persons are required, the \$600 will need to be further divided. This includes Airfence setup, teardown, and maintenance assistance.	\$200/pp \$600 total

Monthly Positions

These positions are paid monthly.

Yearly Positions

These positions are paid yearly.

Position	Job Responsibilities	Rate
Tech Assistant	Eligible if serves as a volunteer at 3 or more race rounds. Paid as a race license credit for the following year; valued at \$200.	\$200.00
